May 1 Space Available List

Thank you to those schools that already submitted the *Post-May 1 TE Scholarships Available* survey. If you <u>DO</u> still have TE Scholarships to offer for this coming fall and students are still able to apply for admission to your school, add your school to the **Post-May 1 TE Scholarships Available List**, posted on tuitionexchange.org for students/families to view. Since the launch of the new TELO system, a few schools have requested that "Graduated" be added as an Import status. Good news-it



has been! Keep in mind - there's no need to update all of your Import students that are graduating this May/August to this status if their *Eligibility Remaining* field shows they only have one semester of TE eligibility remaining prior to the May 31 semester increment process occurring in the TELO system. This process, which runs at the end of each semester, will reduce students' *Eligibility Remaining* count by one semester if they were enrolled for the spring 2025 semester and these applications will automatically close out in the

TE Truth or Tall Tale?

Is it true that, in order for a TE member school to certify their

TELO system on July 1; however, if you have a student who is graduating a semester early, before they have exhausted their *Eligibility Remaining* count, you can now update their Import status to "Graduated" after their final semester to close out their application in advance of when the system would automatically do so.

Grab a Seat on the TE Express!

Interested in your school being featured on the new TE Express School Search? TE member schools can opt into the TE Express lead generation student/parent contact service. to receive information from those students that would like more information about your school. The lead gen service will help TE member schools connect with high-intent students earlier in the college search process and those that sign on for the lead gen platform appear as Featured Schools on the new TE College Search page. The lead gen fee (paid to Carnegie) is \$2,000/year for an unlimited number of leads.

TELO Tip of the Month

Did You Know...

That Student Classification (AKA year in school) has been added to the Import Report? Several schools requested this enhancement in order to more efficiently review their Import applications and more easily identify first-year versus upper-class students. Don't forget--student Date of Birth can also be added to your Import report, simply click on COLUMNS and toggle over to have that field added to your report, which you can export to Excel.

faculty, staff or dependents as eligible TE Exports for graduate programs, that they have to offer TE Scholarships to their own school at the graduate level? That's a TE Tall Tale! Just as there is no requirement to balance Exports and Imports (effective Fall 2020), schools are not required to have the same criteria for their Export students as they do for their Import students.

Spring Cleaning? Check Those TE URL's!

TE Central has recently received some inquiries from families at TE member schools asking about "bad TE links" they found on their school's website or in email communications from their school. Please be sure any TE url's you are providing to your faculty/staff, or have published on your school's website, link to the correct page the new tuitionexchange.org website. For example, if you have an email template or information on your website that references the TE EZ-Application video, those links have changed with the launch of the new website.

TE Central will be holding annual, live training webinars for the upcoming 2026-2027 application cycle before the new 2026-2027 TE EZ-Application opens on July 1, 2025. All schools must set up their information in the TELO system for the 2026-2027 year by June 20th. Sessions will review how to complete the new year setup as well as TE reports, change logs and updates to the TELO system and enrollment review processes for the upcoming 2026-2027 application cycle.
