Is Your School Set Up for July 1?

If you have not had the opportunity to attend a 2026-27 Cycle Kick-Off Training for TELOs, time is running out! Please register to attend our Wednesday, June 18 2:00-3:00 p.m. EST session to ensure you know how to update your 2026-2027 school setup in the TELO system and to learn more about the *new* steps in the enrollment review process. The 2026-2027 TE EZ-Application opens on July 1, 2025. Complete your 2026-2027 setup by June 30th to ensure your school shows up on the school list for your Exports to select, and for prospective Imports interested in attending your school to select! If you do not complete your 2026-2027 Annual Aid Year School Information in the TELO system, and update your Users and School Profile, your school will be grayed out your TE scholarship profile tuitionexchange.org will not be accurate.

Planning to Offer TE at Graduate/Doctoral Level?

If your school is planning to offer TE scholarships to students enrolling at the graduate or professional level, be sure accurate



information is listed for your school on the TE **Graduate School Search** page. Forward this **survey** to your Director of Graduate Admissions to complete and submit directly to Carnegie, who manages the graduate school search information. While the **Undergraduate TE College Search** pulls from the federal IPEDS data your school submits, the TE Graduate School Search pulls data

The time has come for the 2024-2025 TE EZ-Application to sail away! The 2024-2025 application will close out June 30, 2025. After that date, students will not be able to complete the TE EZ-Application for that year.

Additionally, all 2024-2025 applications that are NOT in an Enrolled status (note-apps in LOA status are exempt) will automatically close out on June 30, 2025 in the system. Please review all of your Import 2024-2025 records for ensure they were either Enrolled or updated accordingly to the correct Import status before June 30, 2025!

TELO Tip of the Month

Did You Know...

The "eligibility increment" process ran in the TELO system on 5/31/25 to update the *Eligibility Remaining* field for students that were "Enrolled" by their Import schools for the 2024-2025 year? This internal system process reduced the *Eligibility Remaining* field by one for those students who utilized TE during the spring 2025 semester.

The "eligibility increment" process runs on:

- 12/31: Fall Term
- 3/15 (quarter/trimester schools only)
- 5/31: Spring Term8/15: Summer Term

It's a good idea to review your Imports before the process runs each semester as the application for any student with one (or fewer) semesters of *Eligibility Remaining* will be automatically closed out in the system when it does run. If the student will continue to be enrolled, t is best to click the "EXTEND ELIGIBILITY" button on the Import application to add one semester of *Eligibility Remaining* to the student's application beforehand as, once the application closes out, this will not be an option and the student will be required to complete a new TE EZ-Application.

To Apply or Not to Apply...That's the Question...

Just a friendly reminder that continuing TE scholars that are enrolled at an Import school and are currently receiving TE do NOT need to complete a new TE-EZ Application in future years unless:

- 1) They decide to transfer or
- 2) Their parent separates from employment at the original Export school and accepts a position at another TE member school where they/their dependent are TE eligible.

Old Habits Die Hard....Recertification Redacted!

Just a friendly reminder, with the transition to the new TELO system last summer, annual recertification of continuing TE students was eliminated. Schools only need to review their Exports to ensure they remain eligible according to their school's TE certification guidelines. They should also review their Continuing Imports each semester to ensure they remain enrolled, updating the Import status for any that will not be enrolled accordingly. These "enrollment reviews" should be completed each semester, by September 30th for the fall and by January 30th for the spring semester.
