Check Those Imports Before Time Runs Out!

On May 31st, an "eligibility increment" process will auto-run in the TELO system which will **auto-close out the TE EZ-Applications** for any student who has (prior to May 31st), only one (1) semester of *Eligibility Remaining*, along with any student whose application remained inactive during the 2025-2026 year and was not updated to "Enrolled" status within the last 12 months.

To ensure none of your Import students' applications close out before they should, review all of the Imports listed on your Enrollment Report. If any have a "1" listed in the *Eligibility Remaining* column, confirm they will not be receiving a TE Scholarship during the upcoming 2026-2027 year. In the event that they will be, ensure you click the "Extend Eligibility" button to add additional semesters of TE eligibility **BEFORE May 31st!**

Back by Popular Demand...

Since the launch of the TELO system in summer of 2024, many of you have lamented the loss of the "Waitlist" Import status. TE Central is happy to report that the *Waitlist* status has been reinstated! Additionally, here are a few other system enhancements that recently launched in the TELO system:

- Added *Denied-Not Admitted* Import status
- Student scholarship award amount was added to the Export section of the Enrollment Report
- A separate Graduate Import Application deadline was added to the *Annual Aid Year School Information* view for schools that offer TE at the graduate level
- When a student creates their TE account, they will now receive an auto email reminding them that they must check their TE account regularly for status updates

TELO Tip of the Month

Did You Know...

That the TE EZ-Application for any of your Import students that are graduating in May, and currently only have only one (1) semester of Eligibility Remaining, will automatically close out in the system? There's no need for you to update their Import status to *Graduated*! If, however, you have an *Enrolled* Import student who has graduated this semester and currently has an *Eligibility Remaining* count greater than one (1), you would want to update their Import status to *Graduated* as their application will not auto-close in the system.

TE & Closing Schools

As it has in the past, TE Central continues to support families affected by school closures or mergers. Students who are currently enrolled and receiving a TE Scholarship - or who have already been Export Approved for the upcoming cycle - may purchase remaining semesters of TE Export eligibility through the completion of their degree



program, ensuring their studies are not disrupted by their parent's school closing or merging. In these situations, Import schools are asked to honor the terms of the original TE scholarship offered the student, and the student will remain "Export Approved" in the TELO system.
